Old Windsor Neighbourhood Plan Consultation Extended

Over the last 18 months or so the Parish Council Neighbourhood Planning team have been busy talking to residents, commissioning reports and gathering data to enable us to formulate the various policies that make up the Plan.

The aim of the Neighbourhood Plan is to help influence future planning in our Parish. Once adopted the plan will have legal weight and will be used when making planning decisions in the Parish.

Working closely with our Planning Consultant and officers from RBWM we have devised 22 policies that aim to cover the various elements and topics that you, our residents, have told us are important to you.

This stage of the process has been extended until September 23rd 2016.. We will then make any necessary changes or amendments and then pass it to RBWM for inspection and coherence with the Borough Local Plan

After this the Plan will go for independent examination and finally back to the community for referendum.

The Plan needs 50% of those who vote to agree to its adoption.

Once the Plan is in place we will be entitled to 25% of any Community Infrastructure Levy imposed on new development in our area. This money will be used to support development by funding infrastructure that the council, local community and neighbourhood want. Without a Plan we would only be entitled to 15%.

We've already received useful comments from some of the statutory consultees such as Historic England, Thames Water and RBWM but it's really vital that we know what you think about the Plan.
