Members had an OBJECTION to this application.

- Members felt that this was an overdevelopment of the site and over prominent on a corner plot.
- Members believe there is insufficient parking for a four bedroom house. The two parking spots on the side of the house are sub-standard sizing at 4.45m deep and only 4.7m wide compared to the standard guideline of 4.8m deep and 4.8m wide for two spots. The cars on the drawings are only 4m long to make it look like there is sufficient room. The average UK car is about 4.4m long.
- This application is contrary to the Old Windsor Neighbourhood Plan policies OW4: Residential Infill and Backland Development and also OW8: Townscape.
- We believe it is also contrary to the RBWM BLP policy QP3: Character and Design of New Development.
